 4. Kite papers flower making for Std: VIII on 13th July 2019.



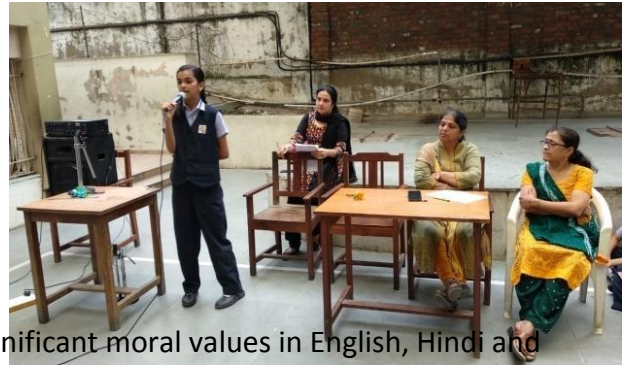
REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST
